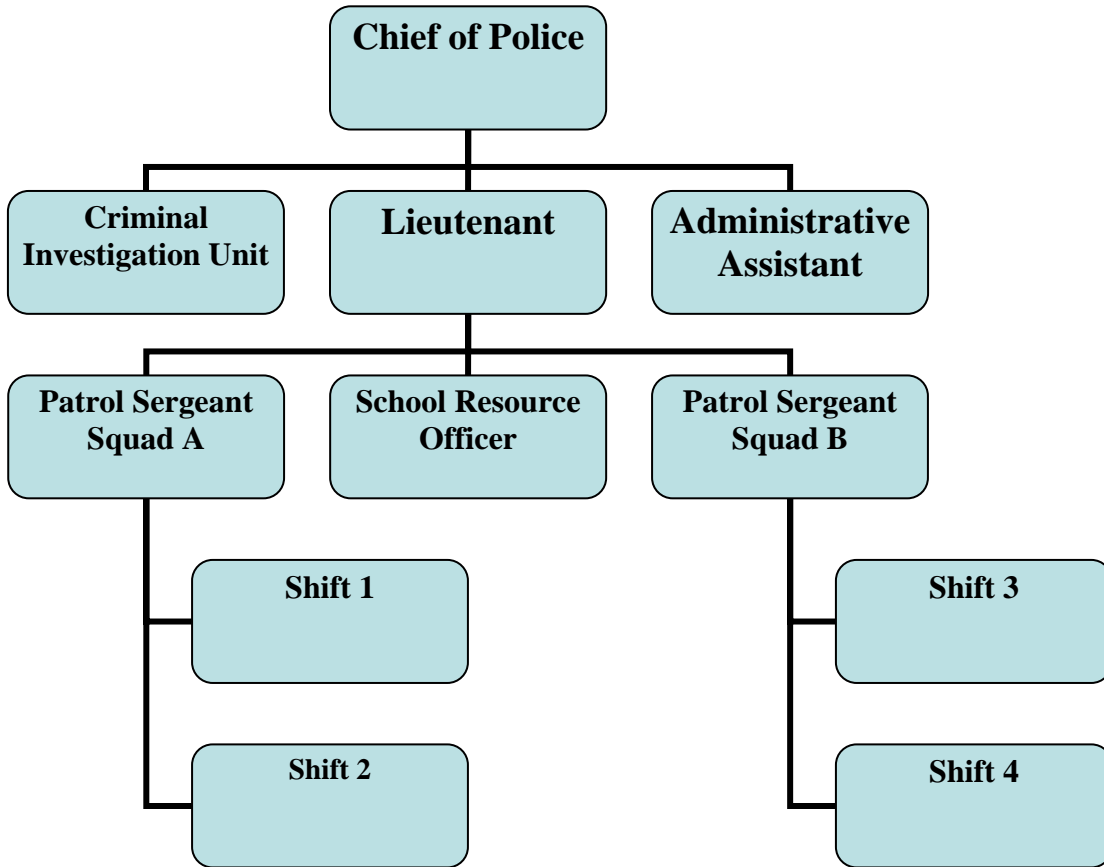

3. D.U.I. Saturation Patrol Arrests – 0

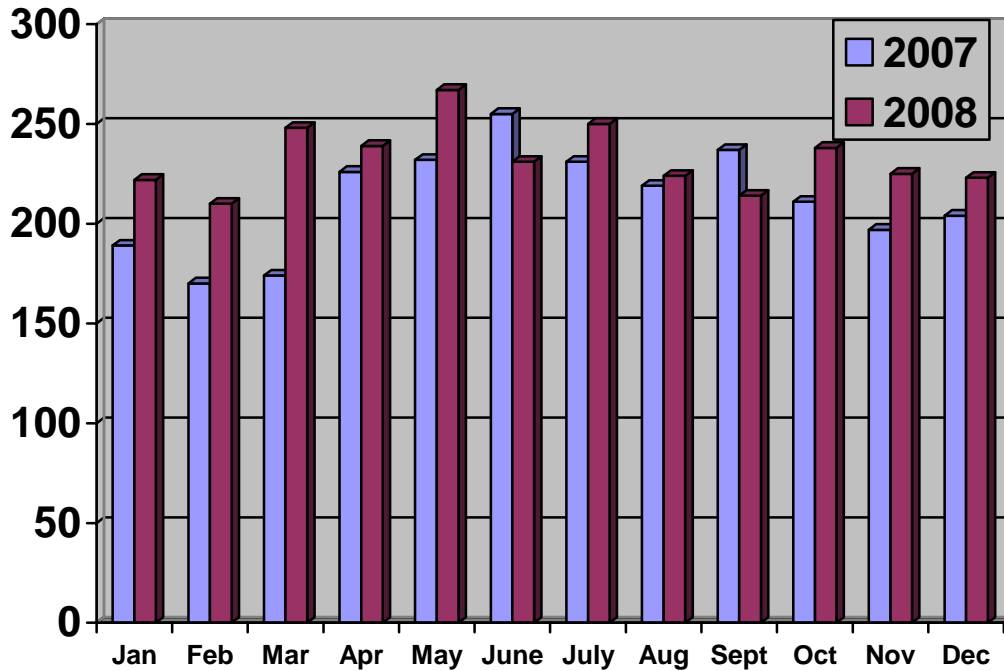
Community Service Projects

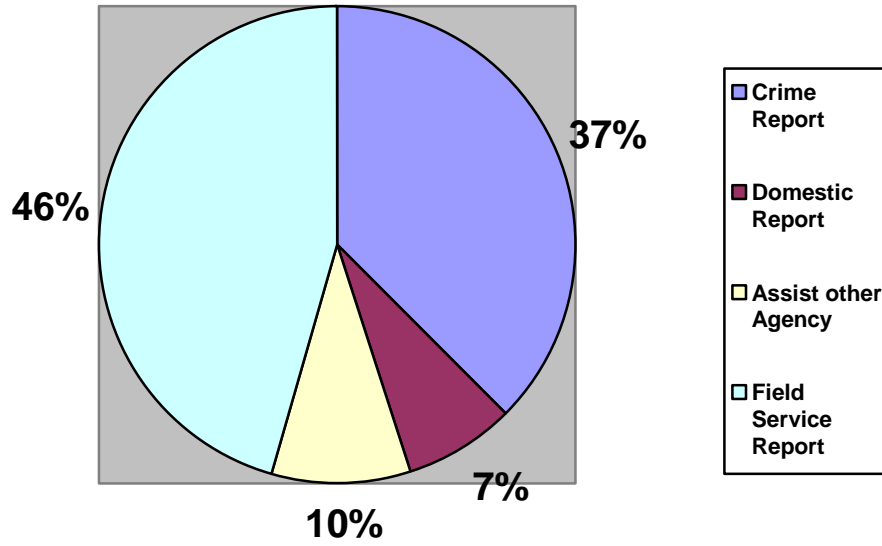

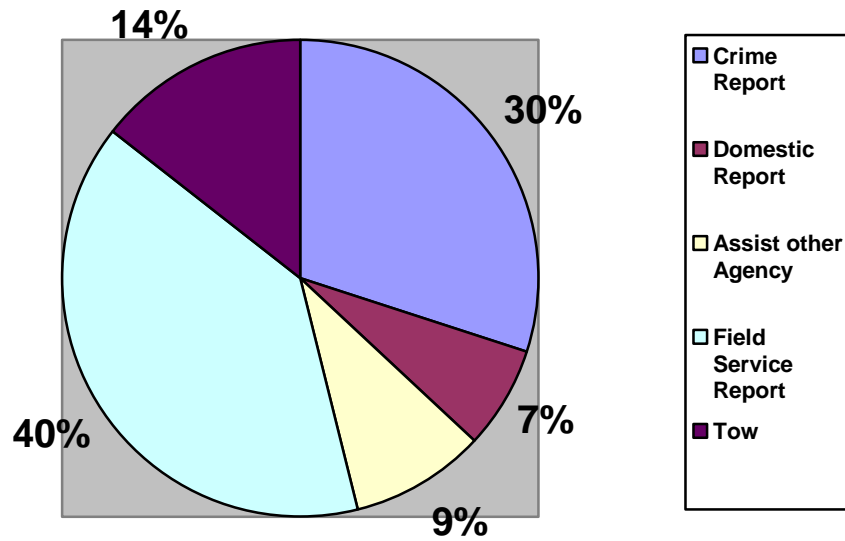

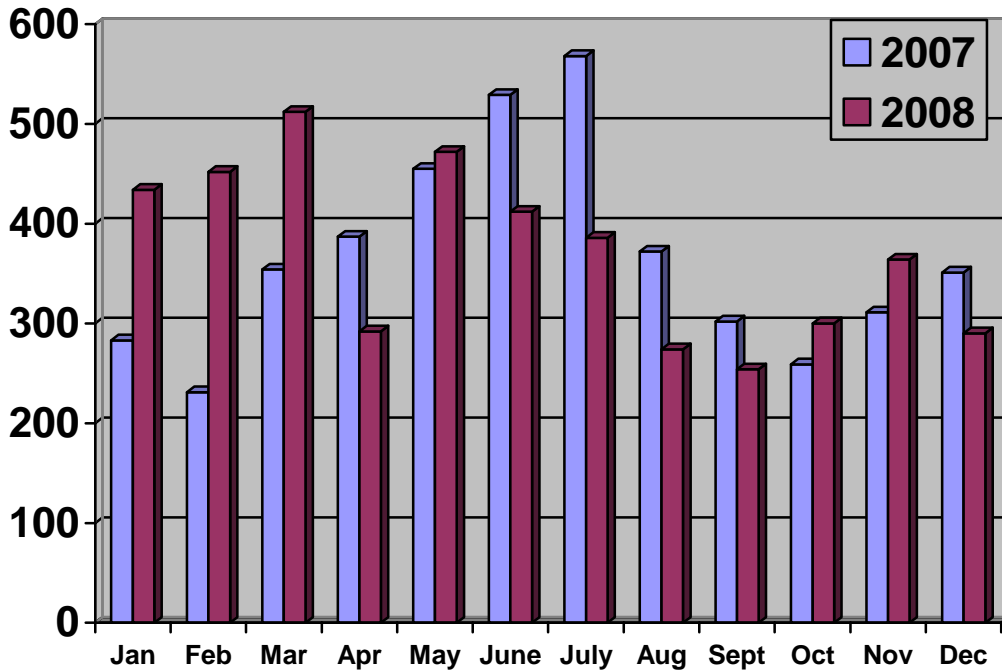

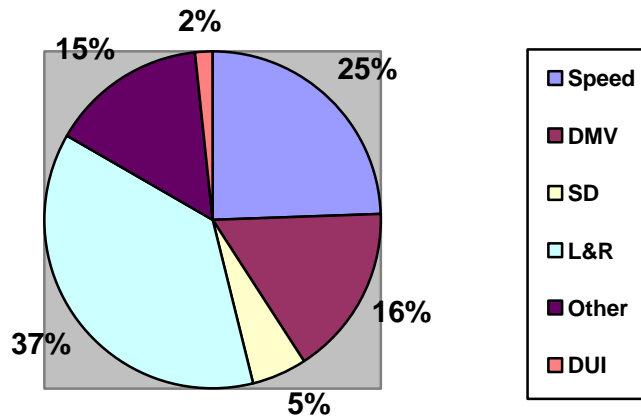


Traffic Arrest Totals 2007 -2008

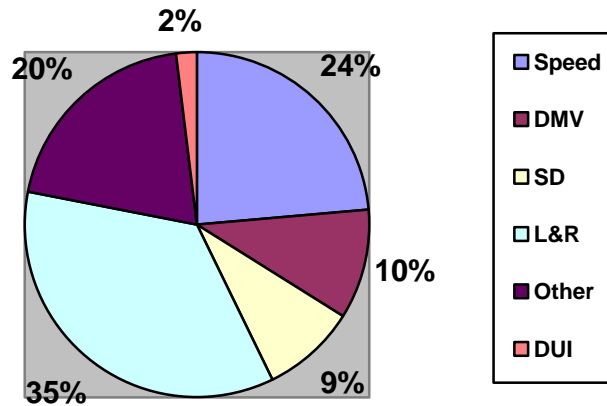

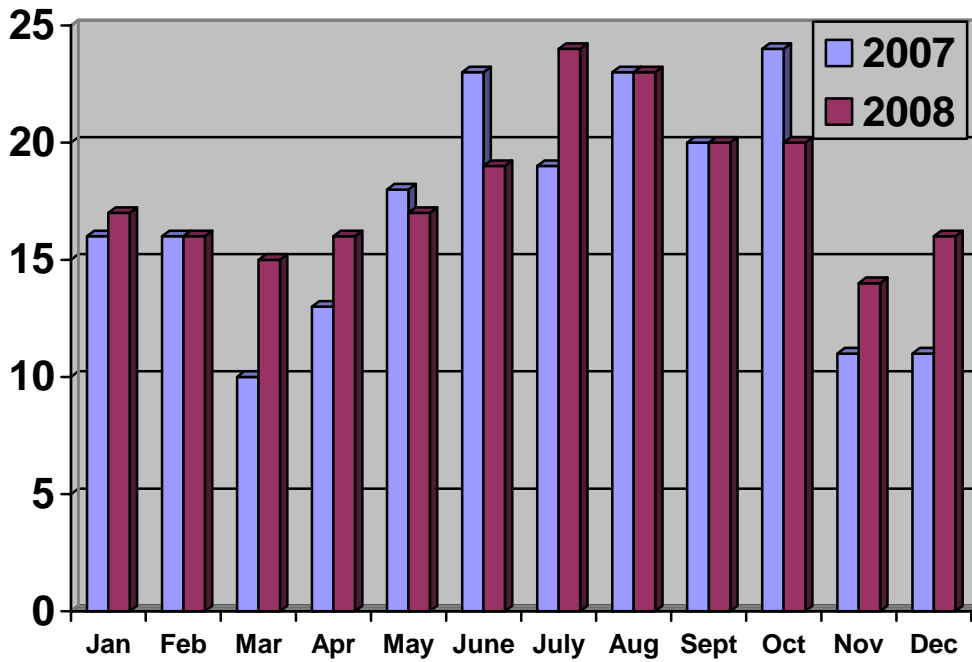

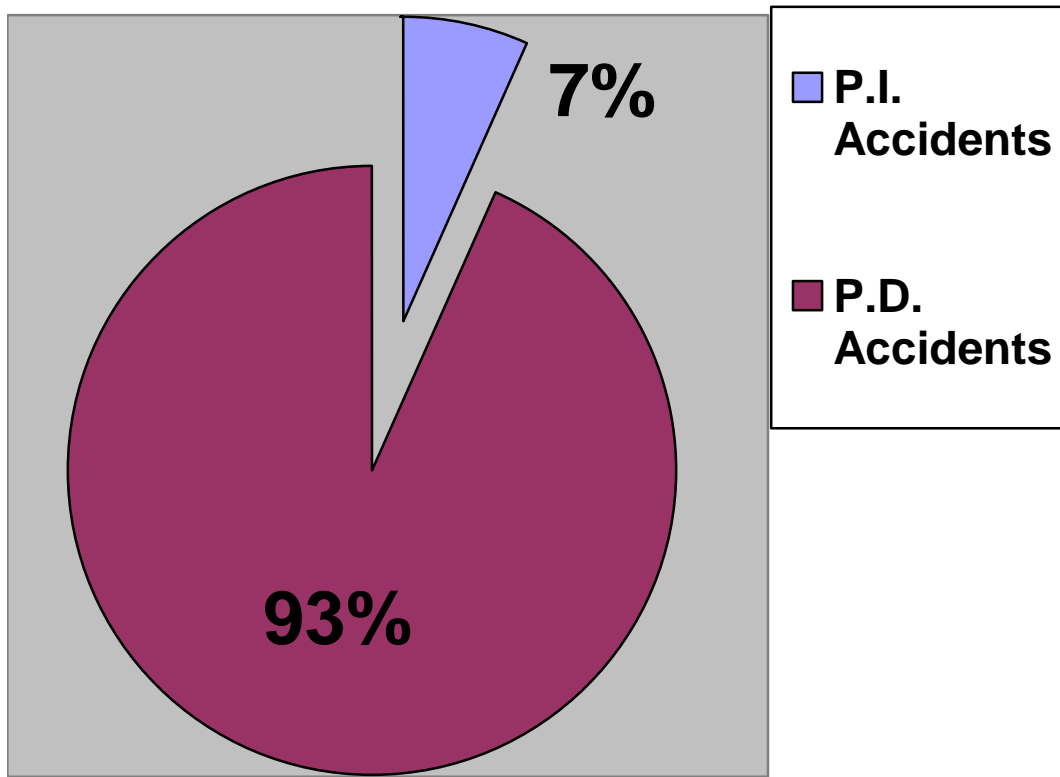

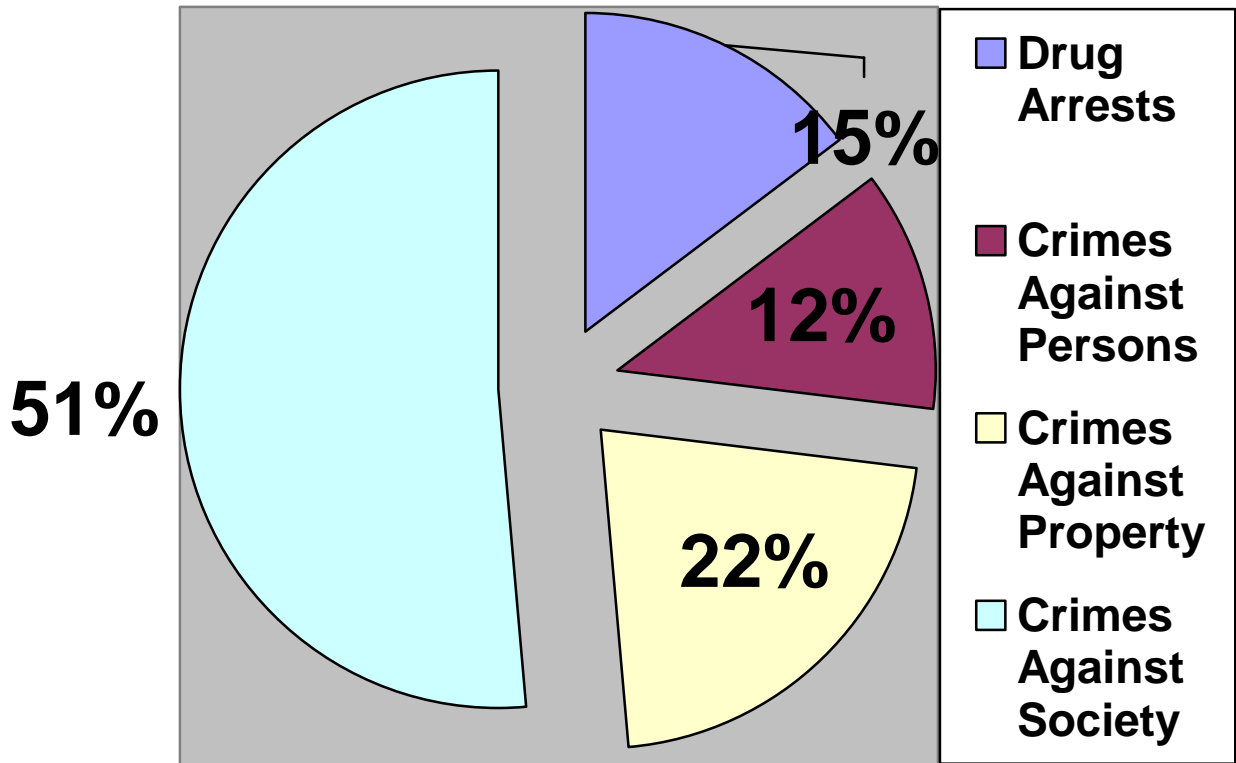


Criminal Arrest Totals

2007 – Total Criminal Arrests – 669

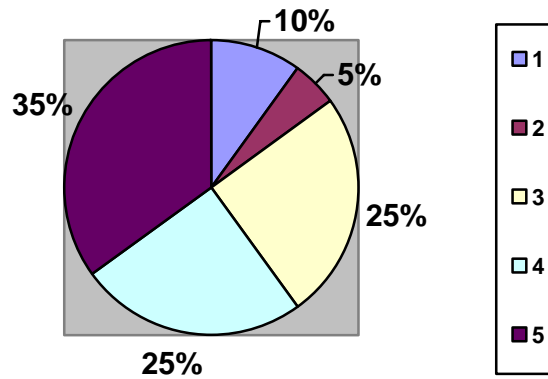

Criminal Arrests 2008



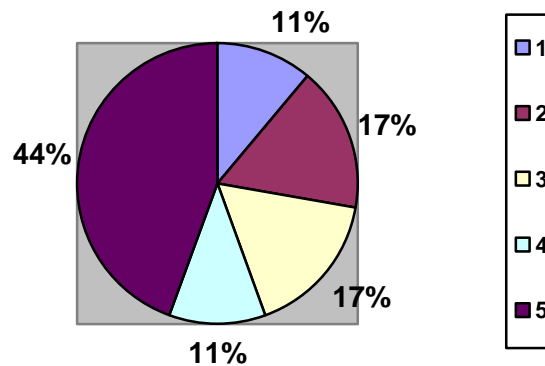
Citizen Survey Results 2008

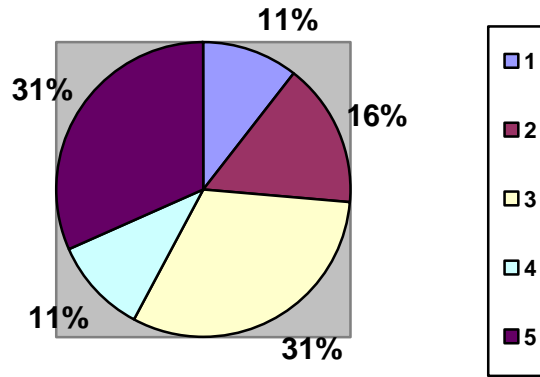
1. How would you rate your experience with the Millsboro Police Department's overall performance?

- 1- Very Poor (10%)



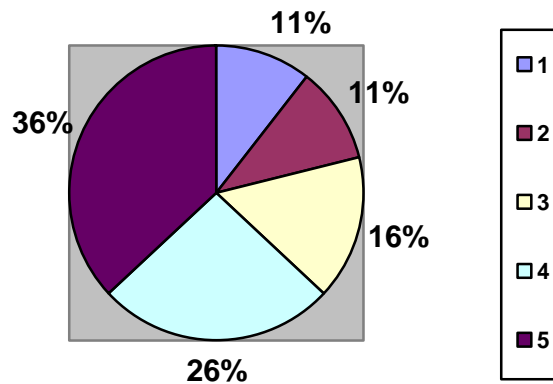
2. How would you rate the overall competence of Officers within the Millsboro Police Department?
